PROFESSIONAL PROFILE

Registered nurse with more than 19 years of progressive clinical practice spanning psychiatric nursing, emergency medicine, critical care, trauma, clinical research, nursing informatics, education, and healthcare leadership. Holds an MSN in Nursing Informatics and is completing post-master's preparation as a Psychiatric Mental Health Nurse Practitioner. Founder of the Psychedelic Experience Registry (PER), an independent participant-centered longitudinal registry under development to support structured documentation of psychedelic experiences, safety, wellbeing, and outcomes over time. Current work focuses on privacy-conscious registry architecture, participant-reported outcomes, longitudinal follow-up, data provenance, consent governance, standardized-measure governance, safety-event capture, and responsible real-world evidence generation.

Psychedelic Experience Registry (PER)

Founder & Project Lead | 2026-Present

- Founded and lead development of an independent participant-centered longitudinal registry and public educational resource focused on structured documentation of psychedelic experiences and outcomes over time.
- Designed a hierarchical longitudinal data model linking pseudonymous participants, research profiles, experience episodes, context, exposures/co-exposures, pre-experience and acute assessments, safety events, and follow-up at 24 hours, 7 days, 30 days, 90 days, 180 days, and 365 days.
- Developed participant-control architecture separating ordinary platform participation from explicit research permission, with versioned consent, withdrawal, re-consent, provenance-preserving edits, and research-use eligibility controls.
- Established governance workflows for standardized instruments addressing source provenance, reuse rights, exact form/version, scoring, timing, missingness, translation, and implementation gates before measure deployment.
- Developed privacy- and quality-focused requirements for pseudonymous identifiers, data minimization, role-based administrative access, auditability, versioned data dictionaries, disclosure review, and research export.
- Designed structured safety-event and outcome capture to preserve benefit, no meaningful change, mixed outcomes, deterioration, and harm rather than privileging positive reports.
- Prepared and submitted PER's September 2026 organizational public comment to FDA Docket FDA-2026-N-7542 on longitudinal real-world evidence, coordinated registry infrastructure, common data elements, participant-reported outcomes, safety-event standardization, interoperability, privacy, data quality, and long-term follow-up.
- Built the project as a nursing-informatics application integrating clinical domain knowledge, participant-generated data, information architecture, governance, and research-readiness.
